01: Welcome, quorum & organisational matters

Emil, as moderator, welcomes all those present punctually at 18:49 and notes that six people are initially present, three of whom are members of the Youth Committee. There is therefore no quorum. Marius writes the minutes. The entire meeting will be held in English today because Nele is writing an English test at school tomorrow - true to the motto 'Learning by Doing' (it is English after all hehe).

02: Open Space / Open Fridge

The group has a brief chat about the everyday madness experienced by the average Falkensee teenager. Fortunately, the fridge is empty and clean, but it still stinks.

03: Status of tasks

The current tasks on the Anytype pipeline are processed and compared. The organisation of the summer cinema is running according to the distribution of tasks from the last event meeting. Marius and Charlotte have written to the city administration again regarding the school concept. In the meantime, Charlotte is organising a project for Brandenburg Women's Week. 04: Photo marathon

Marius reports on the plans for this year's photo marathon, which has been organised together with KuKuFo for years, and explains the concept of the event.

This year, the photo marathon is to take place in May as part of the Miteinander! festival and the award ceremony will then be held as part of the city festival in September. He asks if anyone would like to help with the preparation and realisation. Emil agrees and will organise this year's photo marathon with Michaela from KuKuFo.

05: Equal Pay Day

Marius talks about a request he received from Brücke Frauen Falkensee. On 7th Mar. 2025 from 3-5 pm, information material on Equal Pay Day will be distributed at the bus



station/Sparkasse location. Most of them are already pensioners and the topic actually concerns working women and especially younger women, according to the Brücke Frauen. They would therefore be delighted if they were supported by the young women from the youth forum. Charlotte, Nele and Johanna have agreed to do this - Charlotte will be in charge of communication.

06: Current status of the youth fund

Marius informs about the current financial situation. Due to the break-up of the traffic light coalition, there is still no federal budget for 2025, which makes it more complicated to deal with the funding this year. However, Stefan has now given the go-ahead for us to spend the €18,000 available to us. However, we should still use it sparingly, as something may still have to be transferred to the action fund by the end of the year. We should also make a rough financial plan for this year. There will only be final certainty when there is a new federal government and a federal budget.

07: Last questions, Miscellaneous

Marius informs us that our website should finally be translated into both English and plain language - in the interests of accessibility. There is now an offer to professionally supervise the translation into plain language. The company in question will prepare an offer so that we can discuss at the next meeting whether we want to afford this this year.
